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Day 7: Disembark and proceed to Dhenkanal Palace for a visit and an overnight stay.

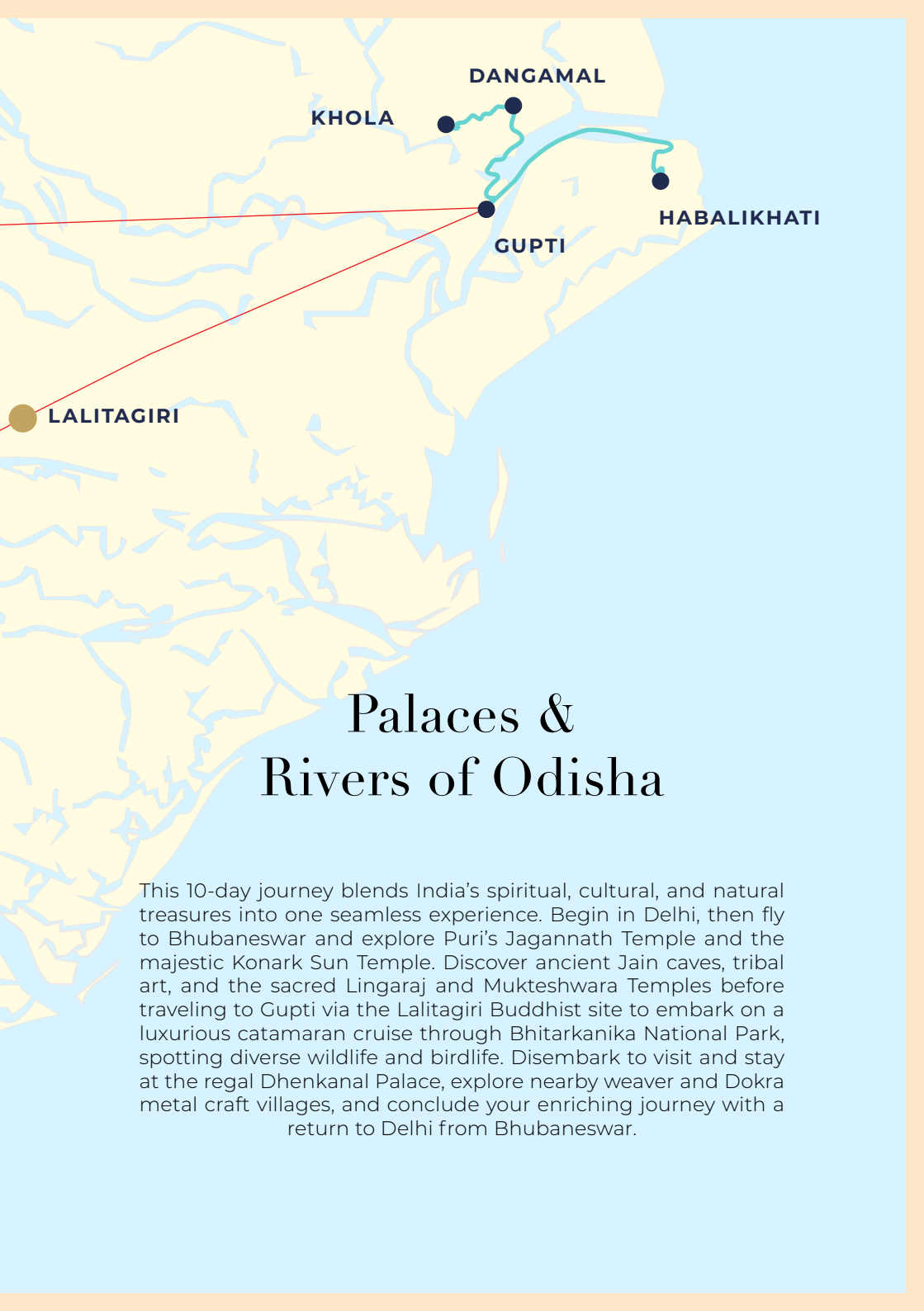

Palaces & Rivers of Odisha

Discover ancient Jain caves, tribal art, and the sacred Lingaraj and Mukteshwara Temples before traveling to Gupti via the Lalitagiri Buddhist site to embark on a luxurious catamaran cruise through Bhitarkanika National Park, spotting diverse wildlife and birdlife. Disembark to visit and stay at the regal Dhenkanal Palace, explore nearby weaver and Dokra metal craft villages, and conclude your enriching journey with a return to Delhi from Bhubaneswar.

Temples, Tea & Textiles

This 12-day journey blends Bengal's cultural richness with the tranquility of the Himalayas. Begin in Kolkata, exploring its colonial landmarks and artistic quarters before embarking on a luxury river cruise aboard Ganges Voyager.
